#### 1. Your Council

Following the elections on 4<sup>th</sup> May, the following councillors were re-elected: Steve Bosson, Deryck Dipper, Kim Saban, Natasha Smyth, Martin Spackman.

Lynn Palmer stood for election and has joined the Council, There are two vacancies.

Brita-May Hawes, Joyce Spackman and Brian Taylor did not stand for re-election,

Colin Marks continues as Clerk to the Parish Council.

The Chairman thanked all members for their service during the last 4-year term of office and wished those well who are no longer in office.

The Council will seek to fill the vacancies by co-option.

#### 2. Major Project for Summer 2023: Refurbishment of the Wodson Pavilion

- Extensive planning has been completed
- The Contractor has been appointed
- Execution of the work will take place over the Summer Holidays
- The Pavilion is an asset of the community and provides a net income to the Parish.
- Refurbishment includes re-roofing, new external cladding, addition of insulation, new ceilings, internal walls and flooring. Provision of externally accessible toilets will be arranged for the Ware Lions Youth Football Club during their weekend usage.
- NB: Unexpectedly the existing roof was torn off in May '23 and has been resolved via a temporary repair in the interim.
